This letter responds to your Dec 11, 2019 California Public Records Act (“CPRA”) request to the Office of the Mayor of Los Angeles (“Office”) seeking the following:

Please be advised that this Office is currently working as expeditiously as possible to complete multiple CPRA requests from a high volume of requesters. This includes multiple ongoing requests, in addition to a substantial increase in new requests. However, due to staffing shortfalls, the volume of our workload, and the need to balance a number of additional workload responsibilities, we are unable to complete requests as quickly as we would like. In addition, this Office is facing additional constraints on resources due to the COVID-19 pandemic, our ongoing emergency response, and telecommuting limitations.

In light of the above, our Office is unable to produce our next set of non-exempt records by Thursday, November 4, 2021, as originally estimated. We estimate that we will produce the next set of non-exempt records responsive to your Request on Wednesday, November 24, 2021. If it appears that our estimate is not workable, you will be notified in writing.
